

INSET DAYS / STAFF MEETINGS FOR KS1 & KS2

Knowledge and insight into children's behaviour, emotions and learning processes has increased drastically over the last few years.

The sessions listed below provide staff with fresh understanding about the children they teach and care for. The content will increase confidence, resources and skills when teaching and when dealing with everyday school situations.

Understanding Children's Emotional Needs - 2 hours

For Teaching & Support Staff

- The complexities of children's emotions during a school day
- What happens in the brain when emotions escalate
- How to effectively calm children down and re-engage them in learning

Managing Classroom Challenges – 2 hours (age specific)

For Teaching & Support Staff

- Discussion about challenging behaviour: It's objective for the child and the impact on the class
- Methods and approaches for positively dealing with challenging and disruptive behaviour
- Helping children learn from their behaviour and move forward

Understanding Puberty & Effects On Learning in Yr 5&6 – 2 hours

For Teaching & Support Staff

- Fundamental cerebral and cognitive changes that affect behaviour, emotions and attitudes once puberty begins
- Ensuring these changes do not interrupt learning

Equipping Lunchtime Staff -1.5 hours

For Lunchtime Team

- Understanding and managing behaviour in non structured break times
- Dealing positively with angry or aggressive children

Engaging Parents -1.5 hours

For Teaching & Support Staff plus SLT

- The role of parents in facilitating learning
- Reaching 'hard to engage' parents
- Using parental engagement to move children forward in their learning

Managing Friendships -1.5 hours

For Teaching & Support Staff plus Lunchtime Team

- Understanding the potential differences in play between boys and girls
- Understanding the stages of friendship
